Comcast to expand fiber network in key Chicago area business corridors

Today, Comcast also announced an expansion of its fiber network in three key Chicago area business hubs, the Chicago Loop – including the Willis Tower and other iconic buildings – the I-90 corridor from Rosemont/O’Hare International Airport to Schaumburg, and the I-88 corridor in Chicago’s western suburbs, from Oak Brook to Aurora.
