This is the second consecutive year that Comcast Business was named the fastest growing Ethernet provider, which helped drive its ranking up two spots to sixth on the research firm's latest LEADERBOARD based on year-end 2014 U.S. business Ethernet port share results. Vertical Systems Group is recognized worldwide as a leading market research firm and its LEADERBOARD is the industry's foremost benchmark for measuring Ethernet provider market presence based on billable retail port installations.

"Our continued growth and movement up the LEADERBOARD underscores how our comprehensive Ethernet portfolio and unparalleled network reach are finally bringing competitive choice and Gigabit connectivity to more businesses so they can improve operations and better serve their customers."

Underscoring the company's Ethernet momentum, Comcast Business was also recently recognized with four <u>2014 Ethernet Excellence Awards</u> from the Metro Ethernet Forum (MEF), including *Best Service of the Year in North America* (Ethernet @Home), *Best Application of the Year in Health* (Cooper University Health Care), *Best Application of the Year in Government* (Cumberland County Library System), and *Ethernet Industry Person of the Year* (Bill Stemper, president of Comcast Business).

Comcast Business's movement up the LEADERBOARD can be attributed to more businesses moving to Ethernet, rollouts of new Ethernet products, along with significant customer traction across a number of key vertical markets in the past year, including:

- Data Center & Cloud Connectivity <u>C7 Data Centers</u>, <u>Continuum Data Centers</u> and others are expanding network connectivity options with secure, scalable, high-performance Ethernet services from Comcast Business. The company also unveiled a new <u>Ethernet-focused data</u> <u>center and cloud services program</u> to provide customers with more efficient access to multiple cloud services.
